I am requesting funding for the Crisis and Incident Response through Community-led Engagement (CIRCLE) in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Los Angeles located at 200 N Main Street, Suite 1500 Los Angeles, CA 90012

The \$10,000,000 request would help to expand the CIRCLE program within the 37th Congressional District including Koreatown, Boyle Heights, and Crenshaw. CIRCLE is a 24/7 unarmed response program that deploys trained teams to address non-urgent LAPD calls related to unhoused individuals.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because CIRCLE teams respond to crisis situations and assist our unhoused neighbors, including trauma-informed care; de-escalation and harm reduction; crisis intervention; transitional age youth cultural competency; Homeless Management Information System; self-care and wellness; and safety, CPR, and first aid. These units are able to assist local law enforcement by relieving much needed resources.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 34 U.S.C. § 10152
