I am requesting funding for the Culver City Hydrogen Bus Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Culver City, located at 4343 Duquesne Ave, Culver City, CA 90232


The \$4,579,200 request will fund Culver City's Hydrogen Bus Project (Project) that will operationalize hydrogen fuel cell buses (FCEBs) for further conversion to a zero-emission fleet to serve CA-37, the Culver City Bus service area, and the broader region LA, and to comply with the California Air Resources Board's mandate requiring all transit fleets in California to be zero-emission by 2040.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project's geographic impact extends far beyond the immediate vicinity of the project site, addressing issues of accessibility, air quality, and commuting dynamics within the broader Westside, Mid-City, South LA and LA Region, with a particular focus on equity considerations. It will also increase the transportation options for constituents throughout CA-37.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
