I am requesting funding for the Urban Cooling with Cool Pavement and Shade Structures in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Los Angeles located at 200 N Main Street, Suite 1500 Los Angeles, CA 90012.

The \$2,400,000 request would provide for the implementation of cool pavement on street segments with accompanying street trees for shade along the project limits. This project will also include the fabrication and installation of shade structures designed to fit over bus benches at bus stop locations within the hottest areas of South LA and the San Fernando Valley.
