I am requesting funding for the Ladera Heights/Windsor Hills - Vision Zero Pedestrian Crossing Enhancements in the Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works located at 900 South Fremont Avenue, Alhambra, CA 91803.

The \$1,500,000 request will be used to design and install pedestrian crossing enhancements, such as high-visibility crosswalks, accessible pedestrian signals, leading pedestrian intervals, and quick-build curb extensions, along designated Vision Zero Collision Concentration Corridors. This project will enhance pedestrian safety and reduce conflicts between vehicles and pedestrians. These enhancements include high-visibility crosswalks, accessible pedestrian signals, leading pedestrian intervals, and paint/bollard curb extensions along roadways identified as Vision Zero Collision Concentration Corridors.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under 23 USC 133.
