Dear Director Gabbard,

On July 18, 2025, you released a document which you claimed contained “overwhelming evidence” that President Barack Obama and his cabinet “manufactured and politicized” evidence against President Trump related to Russia’s *proven* interference in the 2016 election. This is not only categorically false; it is a dangerous and deliberate distortion of reality. As Director of National Intelligence, your job is to safeguard truth, not spread propaganda. Instead, you have abused your position to promote a partisan narrative rooted in conspiracy and discredited claims.

This is not your first display of poor judgment, but it is your most egregious. The Intelligence Community must be guided by objectivity, professionalism, and fidelity to the facts. You have demonstrated none of these. Instead, you have politicized your office, undermined public trust, and embarrassed the very institution you were entrusted to lead. If you are genuinely interested in the truth, we suggest you speak with your fellow cabinet member, Secretary Marco Rubio, who led the bipartisan Senate Intelligence Committee investigation. Its 2020 report thoroughly debunked the very narrative you now promote, affirming that while Russia interfered in the 2016 election, it did not manipulate any votes.

You said yourself that “egregious abuse of power and blatant rejection of our Constitution threatens the very foundation and integrity of our democratic republic.” We agree, which is why we believe your continued service poses exactly that threat. This is a clear effort to distract the American people from the Trump Administration’s refusal to release the Epstein files. Your blatant misuse of your position as Intelligence Director to shield a 34-time convicted felon and adjudicated rapist from facing the truth is not only a moral failure, but a glaring betrayal of the very Constitution that you swore an oath to uphold.

We call on you to resign immediately so that new leadership can begin the urgent work of restoring integrity, rebuilding trust, and upholding the nonpartisan mission of the Intelligence Community before even more damage is done.


