I am requesting funding for Project imPACT in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Los Angeles located at 200 N Main Street, Suite 1500 Los Angeles, CA 90012

The \$2,500,000 request would help the Office of Community Safety (MOCS) continue to build out direct reentry service programming that enhances post-conviction poverty, and prevent recidivism, with a particular focus on support for housing. MOCS Project imPACT reentry providers provide direct services in 4 key categories: Behavioral Health Therapy, Housing Navigation, Employment Navigation and Case Management, and Legal Aid Support. These comprehensive direct services are provided in CA-37, with some organizations serving areas like South LA.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it is designed to prevent crime through community-led approaches to increase safety and wellbeing.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 34 U.S.C. § 10152
