I am requesting funding for the Jubilo Village Affordable Housing Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Culver City located at 9770 Culver Boulevard, Culver City, CA 90232-0507.

The \$5 million request will provide Jubilo Village; a new 100% affordable housing development at 4464 Sepulveda Boulevard in Culver City with 93 affordable apartments for at-risk and low-income households.
