

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5300
OFFERED BY MS. KAMLAGER-DOVE OF
CALIFORNIA

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1 **SEC. __. REPORT ON AFGHAN WOMEN.**

2 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to the appro-
4 priate congressional committees a report—

5 (1) on the current restrictions imposed by the
6 Taliban on women and girls in Afghanistan since
7 August 2021; and

8 (2) that contains a determination of whether
9 those restrictions amount to—

10 (A) crimes against humanity, as defined in
11 the Rome Statute of the International Criminal
12 Court;

13 (B) torture, as defined in the Convention
14 against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhumane, or
15 Degrading Treatment; or

16 (C) gross violations of human rights, as
17 defined in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961.

1 **SEC. __. ESTABLISHMENT OF A DATABASE DOCUMENTING**
2 **ATROCITIES AGAINST AFGHAN WOMEN.**

3 (a) COLLECTION OF INFORMATION.—The Secretary
4 shall document, verify, and analyze the following informa-
5 tion with respect to human rights violations by the Taliban
6 against Afghan women:

7 (1) Incidents of human rights violations by the
8 Taliban against Afghan women and girls in Afghani-
9 stan.

10 (2) Such other information as the Secretary of
11 State, shall prescribe.

12 (b) DATABASE.—The Secretary shall establish and
13 maintain a database containing the information collected
14 under subsection (a). Information contained in such a
15 database may be classified to the extent necessary and
16 shall protect intelligence sources and methods.

17 (c) AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION.—The Secretary
18 shall make available on a website of the Department the
19 information from the database described in subsection (b)
20 with respect to human rights violations by the Taliban
21 against women and girls, except—

22 (1) information that would compromise law en-
23 forcement or intelligence sources or methods; or

24 (2) information that would expose witnesses or
25 survivors to harm or retaliation.

1 (d) INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO CONGRESS.—Infor-
2 mation omitted from the public database pursuant to sub-
3 section (c) shall be made available to the appropriate con-
4 gressional committees upon request.

5 (e) SUNSET.—This section shall terminate on the day
6 that is 4 years after the date of the enactment of this
7 Act.
