Dear Colleague:

As this week will likely be our last together before the critical November elections, I wanted to respectfully ask for your support in serving as Co-Chair of the Democratic Policy and Communications Committee (DPCC). After what I believe will be a historic election for our caucus, Americans will look to House Democrats for leadership through the remaining years of the dreadful Trump presidency. I want to serve as a bridge between leadership and my fellow colleagues as we face the monumental challenges ahead.

I am ready to bring my experience, relationships, and perspective from Los Angeles to help strengthen how we communicate, collaborate, and deliver for the American people.
